Softball Tournament

Rules:

- Each team must consist of 6 adults and 6 Reedville Players **AT ONE LEVEL** (all midgets, all juniors or all seniors). Tournament will actually be three separate tournaments (midget, junior and senior) all being played at once.
- Rules are standard slow-pitch softball regulations unless otherwise noted prior to the tournament.
- Teams will play “pool play” and then a single elimination championship tournament at their respective level for the “Old Trophy” Championship.
- Games will be played on each level’s field size, so midgets will play at 60-foot bases, juniors at 70-foot bases and seniors at 80-foot bases. Pitching will always be from 50 feet.
- Five run limit per inning; 5 total innings; last inning unlimited runs. **NO MORE THAN 2 HOMERUNS, over a fence or otherwise, will be allowed.** Any homerun over the two home run limit will result in an out.
- **ADULT MUST ALWAYS PITCH.** Every team must play 5 adults and 5 kids in the field each inning.
- Batting lineup must alternate child, adult and each team must hit their entire 12-person roster.
