Coach's Code of Conduct:

- 3. Coaches will provide instruction in a manner that is constructive and supportive.
- 4. Coaches will not ridicule or demean players, umpires, or league officials.
- 5. Coaches will not tolerate behavior that endangers the health or well-being of a child.
- 6. Coaches will comply with the decisions of league officials and observe all rules, policies, and procedures as established or endorsed by Reedville Baseball.
- 7. Coaches will teach the game to the best of their ability and in accordance with the rules and accepted practices of Reedville Baseball Inc.
- 8. Coaches will be drug/alcohol free, while at any Reedville Baseball athletic event.
- 9. Coaches will not use any tobacco products in the dugout or on the playing field.

ZERO TOLERANCE - Reedville Baseball's Board of Directors has implemented a "ZERO TOLERANCE" to all of the aforementioned points. As a Reedville Baseball coach you are a direct representative of our entire organization and we expect and will hold you to the standard set above.

VOUNTEERS MAY BE DISMISSED IF NECESSARY - We understand that you are a volunteer, but we must remember that the game is for the kids, NOT the adults. Failure to comply with this code of conduct will result in discipline by the RBI Board of Directors, and such penalties will result in suspensions of games and or termination of your coaching position. As a Coach, you serve at the pleasure of the Board of Directors and may be dismissed at any time, without cause.
