**Reedville Baseball Parent Code of Conduct:**

4. Leave the umpires out of it. They do not care who wins, and any mistakes are honest ones and my child needs to know that I believe this. Being an umpire is a difficult job, and I will respect this.
5. Maintain self-control. Refrain from disrespectful conduct of any sort, including profanity, obscene gestures, offensive remarks, taunting or other actions that demean any individual. The Board of Directors has adopted a "ZERO TOLERANCE" stance on these points.
6. Condemn the use of threat of violence in any form.
7. Absolutely NO use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is permitted nor will it be tolerated at any practice, game, or event. Smoking or chewing tobacco of any kind is not permitted on or near the fields, dugouts, or spectator areas. The Board of Directors has also adopted a "ZERO TOLERANCE" on these points as well.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following.

- Verbal warning by umpire, head coach, or League Official
- Written warning
- Parental game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by Reedville Baseball Inc.
- Parental season suspension
